PROGRAMS & SERVICE AREA

- Early Childhood, Elementary School, and Middle School Programs (after school and summer camp).
- High School & High School Equivalency Programs (serving over 5000 students a day, the majority of which are at-risk youth who are overage and under-credited or who have dropped out of high school).
- College Access: high school students receive college exploration and access services, including college tours, application assistance, financial aid, and matriculation support.
- Older Adult Programs: enrichment, case management, social services, and daily home-delivered meals for senior citizens.
- Post-Secondary Pathways Program created a school-to-work pipeline, allowing students to earn credentials in growing sectors and pursue viable career pathways.
- Workforce Development: job training, preparation, and adult placement services).

COMMUNITY KITCHEN

NOURISHING A NEIGHBORHOOD

East Side House is building a Community Teaching Kitchen that will provide the community's young adults the opportunity to gain skills in culinary arts, warehouse, and inventory management, earn a driver's license, gain work experience, and be placed in jobs in the food and delivery services industry. The food these young people prepare and deliver will go directly to the families in the community who need it the most. Quite literally, these at-risk young adults will be feeding their own community.



CREATE JOBS

Create 15-20 job opportunities for community residents.



SKILLS TRAINING

Provide 50 young adults per year with real-world skills training and opportunity to earn an industry-recognized certification.



FEED A COMMUNITY

With a commercial kitchen, East Side House will have the capacity to prepare 8,000 meals per week.



PROMOTE HEALTHY LIVING

We will open the kitchen to our other programs and community members and will host a series of activities that promote health, wellness, and nutrition.

OPENING FALL 2025

PATHWAYS TO POST-SECONDARY & CAREER OPPORTUNITIES:

Students will earn certification credentials in the medical and technology fields, and receive basic skills training for entry level positions in CPR & FirstAid, EKG & Phlebotomy, Pharmacy Technician, Cisco, Networking, and Microsoft.

WORK-READINESS OPPORTUNITIES:

Students, in their junior and senior years, will receive hands-on learning opportunities providing exposure to career pathways through internships and job placement efforts. Opportunities will be provided by Bronx Lebanon Hospital, New York Presbyterian Hospital, CUNY Lehman Community College, and Local 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers Union.

PRIMARY PERSON MODEL-PARENT ENGAGEMENT, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SUPPORT:

Upon entry, students will be matched with an adult who will serve as their "go-to" support person - an advisor. The support person will be responsible for monthly check-ins, teacher-student mediation, student-student mediation, tracking academic progress, attendance outreach, communicating with families, serving as a liaison to other needed social services supports, and more.

STEM CURRICULA:

The school will feature a strong STEM curriculum and provide project-based and experiential learning in a collaborative environment, both in the school and as a part of the external career pathways trainings and certifications. A STEM focus prioritizes "hands-on" learning by increasing student engagement and achievement.
